개요

코트디부아르 공화국(Ivory Coast) 정부는 해당 국가로의 모든 수출에 대해 적합성 확인 프로그램을 보유하고 있습니다. 코트디부아르와 거래하는 수출업체/수입업체는 제품이 세관을 통과하기 위해 적합성 확인 프로그램의 요구 사항을 준수해야 합니다.

Intertek은 본 적합성 검증을 수행하도록 승인된 서비스 제공업체 중 하나로 코트디부아르 정부와 계약을 체결했으며 20년 이상 적합성 평가 프로그램을 지원해 왔습니다. Intertek은 모든 발송물에 대한 통관에 필요한 필수 적합성 인증서를 발행할 권한이 있습니다.

적합성 인증서 (CoC)

규제 수입품의 모든 위탁에는 적합성 인증서가 첨부되어야 하며, 화물의 통관을 보장하려면 인증서가 필요합니다. 적합성 인증서 없이 도착하는 배송품은 거부되며 벌금이 부과됩니다. 인증서는 제품이 관련 기술 규정과 국가, 지역 또는 국제 표준을 준수함을 확인합니다.

IVORY COAST VERIFICATION OF CONFORMITY (VOC)

EXPORTER AND IMPORTER GUIDELINES IVORY COAST

OVERVIEW

Exporters/Importers trading with Ivory Coast need to comply with the requirements of the Ministère du Commerce de l'Industrie et de la Promotion des PME (MCIPPME) in order for their goods to clear Ivory Coast Customs. It is mandatory to obtain a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) for Regulated Product shipments prior to exporting into Ivory Coast.

The programme will commence on 15th February 2019. All regulated products scheduled to arrive at Ivory Coast Ports and Borders with a Bill of Lading (B/L) or AWB dated on or after 15th February 2019 should be accompanied with a CoC. The CoC must be presented by the Importer to the Ivory Coast Customs for clearance of their goods. Regulated product shipments arriving at Ivory Coast Ports and Borders without a CoC will be liable for a penalty fee.

The Verification of Conformity (VoC) Programme provides assurance to Ivory Coast consumers of the quality and safety of imported goods.

The three routes are given below:

- Route A for Unregistered/Unlicensed Products
- Route B for Registered Products
- Route C for Licensed Products

PRODUCT COMPLIANCE



Products subject to Certificate of Conformity

All products are regulated under Ivory Coast with the exception of those products that are exempted by the MCIPPME.

Regulated products include but are not limited to the following:

- Food products
- Electrical and Electronic products,
- Cosmetics and Hygiene products,
- Construction Materials
- Packaging
- Vehicle Spare parts, accessories and lubricants
- Machines
- Pressure equipment
- Personal protective equipment
- Products affecting health, safety and environment
- Textiles
- Footwear
- Toys.
- Used products

Products exempted from Certificate of Conformity

The following products do not require a Certificate of Conformity (CoC):

- Gold and other precious metals; Precious stones; Explosives, weapons, ammunitions and other war materials intended for National Armed forces and the Security forces; Live animals; Fresh vegetables and fruits; Fresh deep-frozen or frozen fish; Fresh deep-frozen or frozen meat; Floriculture plants and products; Local products or traditional handicrafts of community origin, Drugs and inputs used in the manufacture of drugs; Current newspapers and periodicals, Postage or Fiscal stamps, Stamped papers, Banknotes, Cheque books, Passports and certain printed documents; Personal belongings and used domestic materials; Used vehicles; Crude or partly refined petroleum; Commercial samples; Express Couriers; Supplies to diplomatic and consular missions, or international organisations, imported for their own purposes; Production machines submitted or exempted under the Investment Code upon request made to the VOC Monitoring Committee; Import goods and equipment for oil and mining operations (benefiting from the Mining and Petroleum Codes).

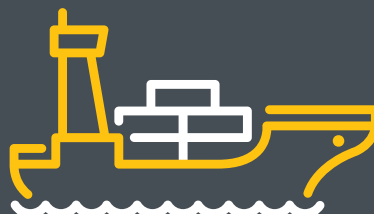
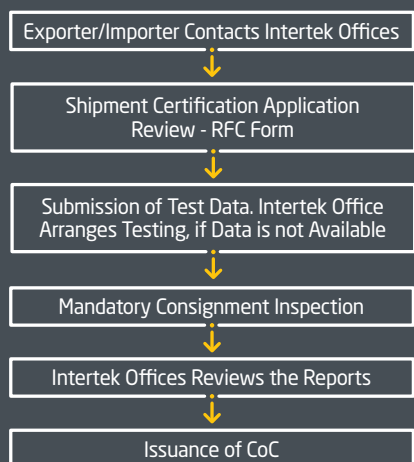

ROUTES TO EXPORT

Unregistered/Unlicensed Products - Route A (For Occasional Exporters)

Intertek offers services in the evaluation of products according to the requirements mandated by MCIPPME. The evaluation process includes the following:

- Physical inspection of goods which includes verification of the product's essential markings and physical requirements as per approved Ivorian Standards and technical regulations.
- Testing according to the applicable product safety standard or technical regulation by an accredited laboratory such as Intertek prior to their export to Ivory Coast.
- Issuance of CoC on successful evaluation of Test Report and physical inspection.

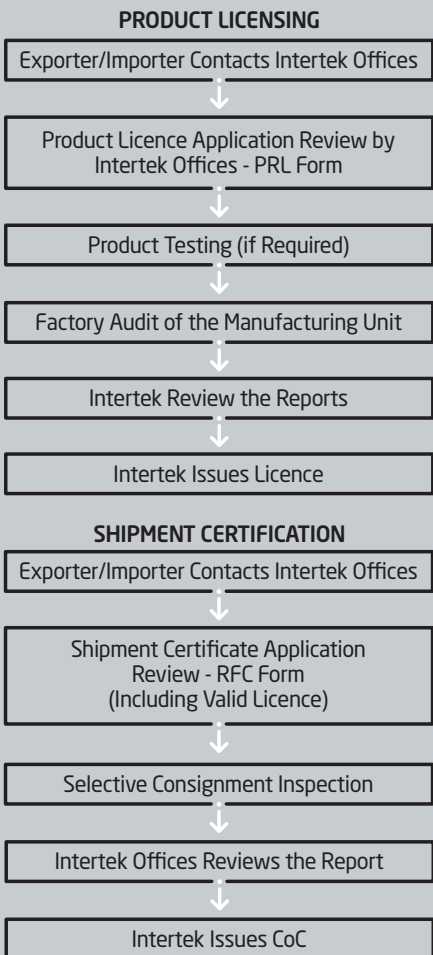
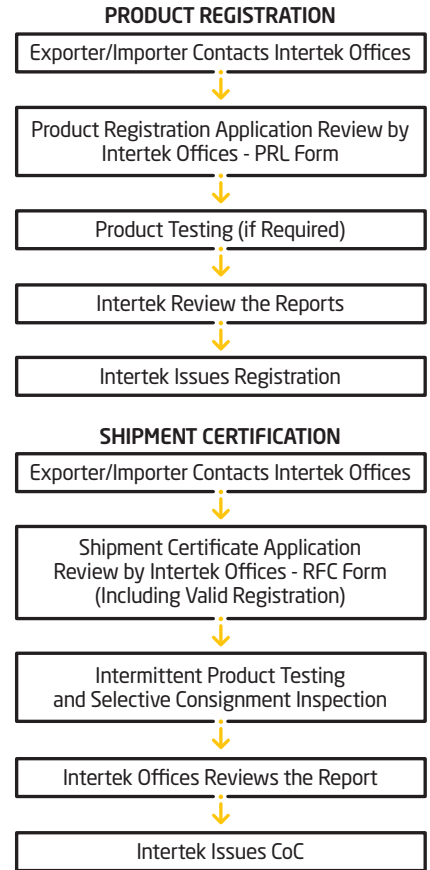

Registered Products - Route B (For Frequent Exporters)

Registration is issued to an Applicant under Route B and can be used for multiple shipments for a period one year from its date of issue:

- Manufacturer / Exporter must demonstrate that their products comply with the Ivorian Essential Requirements, Technical Regulations and approved Standards.
- An assessment to be made that products meet the level of compliance required before Registration is granted. Registered Products exported to Ivory Coast for the first time by an Applicant under VoC programme should have undergone at least one (1) successful shipment through Route A.
- CoC will be issued on the basis of the valid Statement of Registration (SoR) and successful selective inspections of shipments.



Licensed Products - Route C (For High volume Exporters)

Licence is issued to Manufacturers under Route C and can be used for multiple shipments for a period of one year from its date of issue:

- Products must demonstrate full compliance with the Ivorian Essential Requirements, Technical Regulations and approved Standards.
- Licensed Products exported to Ivory Coast for the first time by an Applicant under VoC programme should have undergone at least one (1) successful shipment through Route A.
- Factory audit of all licensed product manufacturing sites to ensure compliance to standard(s).
- CoC will be issued on the basis of the valid Licence and successful selective physical inspections.

FEES

FEES

Shipment Certification Fees

Exporters applying to Intertek for VoC are responsible for the payment of Shipment Certificate Services to Intertek. The Shipment Certification fees include the cost of evaluation, physical inspection of the shipment, all other technical and administrative activities involved in the VoC of the product and are based on the certification route and the percentage of FOB value of the shipment. Intertek offices will provide the applicable fees

to Exporters on receipt of the Request for Certification (RFC) of their shipments to Ivory Coast.

Note that the Shipment Certification fees do not include the product testing cost which is separate and subject to the type of product under test and nature of tests performed. The testing fees will be separately quoted if required and requested to be performed by Intertek.

Registration and Licensing Fees

These fees are subject to type of product being Registered and Licensed. Exporters need to contact local Intertek Offices to obtain the quote. The Registration and Licensing fees do not include testing and auditing services.
